Evidence-based Practical Strategies

- Language acquisition → use explicit instruction to teach new tier two vocabulary
- Strategically arrange your classroom so DHH students are close to areas where you spend the most time teaching
- All school staff should be made aware of strategies to reduce background noise, distance, and reverberation
- Utilise consistent tools and actions that can serve as visual and tactile cues for communication to and between students

Supporting First Nations Students

 Indigenous students have a higher prevalence of otitis media which, if untreated, can lead to significant impacts on ear and personal health, delays in language development, and poor learning outcomes.
