Evidence-based Practical Strategies

- Implement behavioural approaches such as: the PAX Good Behaviour Game and the Prevent-Teach-Reinforce Strategy
- Using PBS/PBIS involves changing the environment, teaching new skills, reinforcing, increasing and planning
- Explicitly teach the age appropriate positive behaviours that you expect and the reasons why we behave in certain ways
- Keep systematic records and understand behavioural approaches do not always produce quick results
- Jointly negotiate and develop behavioural expectations with your students

Supporting First Nations Students

- Teachers should acknowledge and connect with local cultural groups to understand sensitive issues within the culture and language
