Sensory exploration

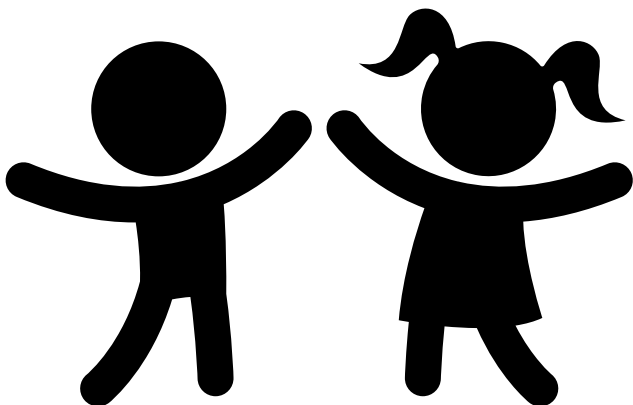
- Classify sensory inputs as tolerable, aversive, or enjoyable
- Understand culturally-appropriate strategies

Reframing

- Challenging behaviours as an expression of overwhelm
- Accommodation provision as a way to help everyone feel included

Autonomy and choice

- Choice in how to manage their sensory environments
- Instill a sense of empowerment to self-advocate
